# 1.1 DANGEROUS GOODS CARRIED BY PASSENGERS OR CREW

1.1.2 The provisions of these Instructions do not apply to the following when carried by passengers or crew members or in baggage, transported by the operator, that has been separated from its owner during transit (e.g. lost baggage or improperly routed baggage):

e) with the approval of the operator(s), as checked baggage only, securely boxed packaged cartridges, (UN 0012 or UN0014 only), for sporting purposes, in Division 1.4S, in quantities

(2 pages) DGP.19.WP.009.2.en.wpd not exceeding 5 kg gross mass per person for that person's own use, excluding ammunition with explosive or incendiary projectiles. Allowances for more than one person must not be combined into one or more packages;
