ACCEPTANCE CHECKLISTS – EXCEPTED QUANTITIES / EXCEPTED PACKAGES

(Presented by J. Abouchaar)

1. **BACKGROUND**

1.1 Part 7;1.1.2 requires that operators must not accept a package, overpack, freight container or unit load device containing dangerous goods unless "he has inspected it, found it to be properly marked and labelled and determined that there is no leakage or other indication that its integrity has been compromised."

1.2 Part 7;1.3 then requires that operators must use a checklist to verify compliance with the relevant parts of the Technical Instructions.

1.3 The wording of 7;1.3 implies that an operator must use an acceptance checklist when accepting packages or overpacks containing dangerous goods in excepted quantities and radioactive material in excepted packages even though there is no stated requirement in 1; 2.4 and 2;7.9 respectively.

2 **PROPOSAL**

2.1 Amend 7;1.3 c), by adding the sentence highlighted, as follows:

To assist in carrying out their responsibilities with respect to the acceptance of dangerous goods, operators must use a checklist. This checklist must include all reasonable steps to establish that:

c) the requirements of 1.1.2 have been fulfilled.

A checklist is not required for dangerous goods in excepted quantities and radioactive material in excepted packages.
