DEFINITION OF TRAINING RECORD

SUMMARY

This working paper proposes adding a new definition for training record in Part 1;3.1 of the Technical Instructions.

Action by the DGP: The DGP is invited to consider adding a new definition for "training record" as shown in the appendix to this working paper.

1. **INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 Tables 1-4 and 1-5 of the Technical Instructions indicate what subject matter specific categories of dangerous goods personnel should be familiar with. These tables have been used by companies of different size and structure. Currently after training on such subject matter, personnel receive educational qualification documents (records of training).
- 1.2 Part 1;4.2.3 defines a validity period for such records of training of 24 months. This allows trained personnel to change employer, keeping valid the record of training.
- 1.3 The competecy-based approach to training and assessment supported by the DGP involves the assessment, development and implementation of unique training programmes, taking into account the size and structure of the organization. In cases when personnel change employers, it is not clear if it would be possible to use a record of training as a qualification statement.
- 1.4 Taking into account that the new competency-based training approach is used in both educational and competency-based training programmes, it is proposed to add a definition for "training record" to Part 1;3.1.

2. **ACTION BY THE DGP**

2.1 The DGP is invited to add a new definition for "training record" in Part 1;3.1 of the Technical Instructions as shown in the appendix to this working paper.
