Annex 6, Part IV, Overview

Applicability

- Operation of RPAS, by operators authorized to conduct international operations within non-segregated controlled airspace and at aerodromes
- International commercial air transport, international general aviation, and international commercial aerial work operations
- Assumes no people/passengers onboard



Annex 6, Part IV, Overview

Standalone Part to Annex 6

- Addressing international operation of RPAS and certification of RPAS Operator
- Not intended to address non-certificated UAS (Drones)

- ICAO Remotely Piloted Aircraft System (RPAS) Concept of Operations (CONOPS) for International IFR Operations
- Annex 6 Parts I, II, and III



Structure

- Follows same flow and format as Annex 6 Part I
 - Assists with cross referencing of standards
 - Varies only when needed
 - Addresses both aeroplanes and helicopters except where specifically required

 - Identified in Chapter 14
