EDITORIAL: ICAO TI's 1; 2.3.2 (b) - DANGEROUS GOODS IN AIR MAIL

(Presented by J. Code)

1. BACKGROUND

1.1 Part 1;2.3.2 (b) of the 2000/2001 ICAO TI's reads:

"The following dangerous goods may be acceptable in mail for air carriage subject to the provisions of the National Postal Authority...

- (b) radioactive material, the activity of which does not exceed one-tenth of that listed in $\underline{\text{Table}}$ $\underline{2-12}$."
- 1.2 Section 579, 'Additional requirements relating to transport by post', IAEA Safety Standards Series Regulations for the Safe Transport of Radioactive Material, TS-R-1, refers to a Table which is equivalent to the ICAO Technical Instruction Table 2-11.

2. PROPOSAL

2.1 Amend Part 1;2.3.2 (b) of the 2003/2004 ICAO TI's to incorporate reference to the appropriate ICAO TI Table:

"The following dangerous goods may be acceptable in mail for air carriage subject to the provisions of the National Postal Authority...

(b) radioactive material, the activity of which does not exceed one-tenth of that listed in $\underline{\text{Table}}$ $\underline{\text{2-11}}$."
