DPO'S APPROVAL FOR LITHIUM BATTERIES

(Presented by B. Carrara)

SUMMARY

This working paper proposes to analyse and discuss paragraph 1;2.3.4 of the Technical Instructions aligned with 11.4 of Annex 18 in order to clarify the issue for a future working paper submission.

Action by the DGP-WG: The DGP is invited to provide comments on the provisions for approval from the CAA to DPOs to introduce the acceptance of lithium batteries presented in Part 1;2.3.4.

1. **INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 Part 1;2.3 of the Technical Instructions contains provisions for the transport of dangerous goods by post. Part 1;2.3.4 establishes a specific approval to be provided by the civil aviation authority before a designated postal operator can introduce the acceptance of lithium batteries.
 - "2.3.4 Before a designated postal operator can introduce the acceptance of lithium batteries as identified in 2.3.2 d) and e) **they** must have received specific approval from the civil aviation authority."
- 1.2 Since in this paragraph the term "designated postal operator" is in the singular form while "lithium batteries" is in the plural form, we ask to whom the word "<u>they</u>" refers. There are three possible interpretations:
 - a) the word "they" refers to designated postal operators;
 - b) the word "they" refers to each lithium battery to be accepted;

- c) the word "they" refers to Part 1;2.3.2 d) and e).
- 1.3 The Spanish version of the Technical Instructions refers directly to the DPO. In this case, there is no misunderstanding.
- 1.4 Interpreting and translating this provision into Portuguese and probably into other non-ICAO languages may cause problems to some States to comply with the original intention of this paragraph.

2. ACTION BY THE DGP-WG

2.1 The DGP-WG is invited to analyse and discuss paragraph 1;2.3.4 of the Technical Instructions in order to clarify the issue and possibly rewrite the paragraph.
