FLTOSP AAA SG

- Authorization, Acceptance and Approval
 - Annex 6 initiative
 - Provisions written consistently based on the level of authorization required



What is an Authorization?

- Top level which includes all oversight activities by a regulator:

An authorization entitles an operator, owner or pilot-in-command to undertake the authorized operations.



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What does this include?

- Specific Approval:

A specific approval is an approval which is documented in the Operations Specifications for commercial air transport operations or in the list of Specific Approvals for non-commercial operations.



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What does this include?

- Approval:

An approval is a formal act by the State of the Operator/State of Registry to approve an application or a proposed change submitted by, or on behalf of, an operator or owner. The approval attests to compliance with the applicable provisions.



What does this include?

- Acceptance:

An acceptance is a written or implicit acknowledgment by the State of the Operator/State of Registry to an operator or owner of a notification submitted by, or on behalf of, that operator or owner.



What is the AAA SG doing?

- Definitions for each type of Authorization
- Standard text for provisions, linked to authorization level



Authorization	Text for the provisions in Annex 6 (Proposed)
Specific Approval	Shall issue a specific approval... e.g. Dangerous Goods
Approval	Shall ensure that the operator... e.g. PBN
Acceptance	The Operator shall... e.g. Aircraft Tracking



Dangerous Goods (Ch. 14)

14.2 OPERATORS WITH NO **SPECIFIC APPROVAL FOR** ~~THE OPERATIONAL APPROVAL TO TRANSPORT OF~~ DANGEROUS GOODS AS CARGO
