**SUMMARY**

This paper proposes that quantity limits be established for lithium batteries contained in equipment.

Action proposed is in paragraph 2.

**1. INTRODUCTION**

1.1 Two proper shipping names are assigned to UN 3091.

1.2 **Lithium batteries packed with equipment** is assigned to packing instruction 918 for both passenger and cargo aircraft; quantity limitations of 5 kg gross mass for passenger aircraft and 35 kg gross mass for cargo aircraft are contained in the packing instruction. **Lithium batteries contained in equipment** is assigned to packing instruction 912. No quantity limit is given, other than “not more than 5 kg of lithium batteries may be contain in any piece of equipment”.

**2. ACTION PROPOSED**

2.1 It is suggested that quantity limits be established for lithium batteries contained in equipment.
