**4.4 REPORTING OF DANGEROUS GOODS
ACCIDENTS AND INCIDENTS**

An operator must report dangerous goods accidents and incidents to the appropriate authorities of the State of the Operator and the State in which the accident or incident occurred in accordance with the reporting requirements of those appropriate authorities.

Note.— This includes incidents involving dangerous goods that are not subject to all or part of the Technical Instructions through the application of a special provision or other exception (for example, an incident involving the short circuiting of a dry cell battery that is required to meet short circuit prevention conditions in a special provision of Part 3, Chapter 3).
