Mark DeNicuolo is CANSO's Safety Program Manager. He joined the association in November 2010 on secondment from the FAA.

Prior to joining CANSO, Mark was the Manager of the Office of Independent Safety Assessment for the FAA Air Traffic Organization (ATO).
