EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This paper presents information related to the key Decisions and Conclusions of the 4th Meeting of the RASG-AFI (RASG-AFI/4), which was held from 12 to13 October 2017, back to back with the 21st Meeting of the APIRG in Nairobi, Kenya.

Action: The Steering Committee is invited to:

- a) note the information contained in this paper; and
- b) provide further guidance for the integration of relevant Decisions and Conclusions of the RASG –AFI/4 in the 2018 and subsequent AFI Plan programme activities

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The main objectives of the RASG-AFI are to develop and implement a work programme that supports the establishment, management and operation of a performance-based safety system for the AFI Region, on the basis of the Global Aviation Safety Plan (GASP).

1.2 The 4th meeting of RASG-AFI was attended by one hundred and ten (110) participants from twenty-nine (29) ICAO Member States, and eleven (11) International/Regional Organizations and Industry.

2. SUMMARY OF THE FOURTH MEETING OF RASG – AFI

2.1 The meeting was provided important information on the Global Aviation Safety Plan and USOAP CMA and discussed the progress made so far to achieve Global and Regional targets including associated challenges in AFI region. The meeting also discussed the overall progress made in the implementation of previous RASG-AFI Decisions and Conclusions, as well as the status of ICAO Plans of Action and the activities of the Safety Support Teams (SSTs). Several presentations

were made by partners and stakeholders on their contributions and programmes within the context of the Conclusions and Decisions as well as work programmes of the RASG-AFI.

2.2 The RASG-AFI/4 meeting made the following key Conclusions and Decisions to be implemented by its subsidiary bodies, States, regional and international organizations, industry and other aviation stakeholders in order to improve aviation safety in the Region. Accordingly, the meeting requested States and stakeholders in particular, to:

- a. establish a national safety plan, including goals and targets consistent with the regional safety plan, and in line with the GASP objectives, including the global aviation safety roadmap, and based on their operational safety needs, in accordance with Assembly Resolution A39-12. In this respect, States requested ICAO to provide further guidance on national safety plans;
- b. implement the relevant provisions of the Ezulwini Ministerial Declaration on Regional Safety Oversight Organizations in Africa, adopted in March 2017 ;
- c. support the proposed global strategy and action plan to improve and strengthen existing RSOOs and the establishment of, and the objectives for a global aviation safety oversight system (GASOS), as well as the AFI Plan study for the strengthening and improvement of RSOOs in Africa;
- d. share tools and examples which support effective safety management implementation through the ICAO safety management implementation website;
- e. fulfil their obligations under the USOAP CMA Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and take actions, as required, to provide up-to-date information on their safety oversight systems;
- f. resolve outstanding SSCs and take proactive steps and put in place effective strategies to prevent the emergence of new ones;
- g. increase their participation in seminars, workshops and training organized by ICAO and other partners within the framework of activities of the SSTs to ensure maximum impact and benefit;
- h. contribute data and embrace and utilize the Annual Safety Reports to improve their respective levels of safety performance;
- i. fully commit to the implementation of their ICAO Plans of action, for States that have already accepted one, and for all others that are yet to do so, to have such plans developed, accepted and implemented in coordination with their ICAO Regional Office;
- j. provide, through the relevant ICAO Regional offices, proposals for amendment to the AFI Plan Programme Document and ROST TORs; and
- k. assess the Human Resources Development Fund (HRDF) for Africa initiative, in order to determine its effectiveness in addressing the capacity building needs of States and seek any improvements necessary.

2.3 The meeting also:

a. endorsed the proposed revised Abuja Safety targets with some observations, and made recommendations on the Air Navigation targets, and accordingly requested the

Secretariat to amend them in collaboration with RASG-AFI Steering Committee (RASC) and APIRG Project Coordination Committee (APCC);

b. reviewed and endorsed the RASG AFI work programme for 2018/19, including activities related to new areas such as cyber threats, RPAS and capacity building; and

c. requested the RASC to explore various avenues, including on-going initiatives of partners, aimed at building the capacity of aviation personnel.

2.4 A summary of the Conclusions and Decisions adopted by the RASG-AFI/4 meeting is provided as **Attachment A** to this DP.
