7. Visas

While all travellers arriving in Nigeria should have a valid passport, Nigerian entry visas are not required for nationals from some countries. Participants are therefore advised to ascertain whether or not they are exempt from the Nigerian visa requirements at the respective Nigerian Embassies/High Commissions.

Participants who will need visa upon arrival should contact the organizers well in advance so that necessary arrangements can be made.

8. Health

Presentation of Yellow fever vaccination certificate is required for travellers over one year of age who arrive from areas where yellow fever cases are reported.
