Classroom Training

Offered at our 10 IATA Training Centers or at the 24 Regional Training Partners worldwide (RTP). All classroom courses are developed and delivered by IATA registered professional instructors

Course fee differ from Non-Members to IATA member and Developing Nations

Most of the courses are a step towards earning an IATA Diploma; the formula is normally successful completion of four courses within two years.



In-Company Training

- All IATA classroom courses can be customized and delivered on location anywhere in the world. They are developed and delivered by IATA Registered professional instructors
- ↗ Ideally for groups of 10 up to 20 participants
- ↗ Reduces the training expenses considerably



Distance Learning/E-learning

- Mainly offered through IATA Authorized Training Partners (ATCs and ATSs)
- Offered as Self Study training. Participants register directly via our website using a manual, e-book or both, and write the exam locally.
- ↗ E-learning. Interactive materials and online exams and certificate.
