I have the honour to inform you that the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) under the Regional Comprehensive Implementation Plan for Aviation Safety in Africa (AFI Plan) is organizing a Workshop on Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air in Banjul, Gambia, from 4 to 8 June 2012 at the kind invitation of the Government of the Republic of Gambia.

The Workshop is designed for civil aviation authorities and aviation services providers in the AFI Region. These include: regulators, air carriers, flight and ground personnel, who prepare and sign the shipping documents for air transport, personnel responsible for classifying hazardous products, and many others in the industry who would need to understand international standards and technical requirements for the transport by air of dangerous goods.

It aims at helping civil aviation personnel to understand the ICAO Standards, Technical Requirements and the concept of the safe transport of dangerous goods by air.
