- ICAO provides provisions (SARPs and guidance material) to the States;
- The States establish regulations in accordance with the SARPs;
- Operators develop policies to comply with their State's regulations.

Fatigue Management SARPs

The State:

Must have regulations for managing fatigue based on scientific principles

- Mandatory Prescriptive Regulations
- Optional FRMS Regulations





The Operator:

Where FRMS regulations are offered, can choose how to manage their fatigue risks

- Complying with prescriptive regulations; or
- An FRMS for all operations; or
- An FRMS for some operations and prescriptive regulations for the remainder of the operations.





- Variations to FTLs on the basis of a risk assessment.
- → Maintain records of flight and duty periods.
- → FRMS processes must be functioning before approval can be given by State.
- → Outer parameters to be identified.
- ✤ Recommendation: Integration with SMS.


