Objective of the Programme



The objective of USOAP under the CMA is:

 to promote global aviation safety through continuous monitoring of the Member States' safety oversight capabilities.

What is Safety Oversight?



Safety oversight is a function by which States ensure the effective implementation of:

ICAO Standards and Recommended Practices (SARPs) The critical elements of a safety oversight system

Relevant safety practices and procedures

Safety Oversight is a State's responsibility

Critical Elements of an Effective Safety Oversight System



CEs are essentially the safety defense tools of a safety oversight system.

They are required for the effective implementation of safety-related SARPs and associated procedures.

They cover the whole spectrum of civil aviation activities.

The level of effective implementation of the CEs is an indication of a State's capability for safety oversight.

So what are we looking for?



Flight time & Duty time limitations

IF FRMS is authorized

Additional regulations required

Regulations are **Mandatory** (CE-2)

Air operators implementing requirements (CE-6) procedures and guidance material detailing the approval process

approve the air operator's FRMS following an established plan and process

CAA to ensure air operators maintain current records CE-7

CAA to implement FRMS surveillance plan CE-7 And enforcement procedures CE-8




- USOAP-CMA is a mandatory programme applied to all ICAO member States
- Additional audit protocol questions have been developed specifically related to the approval and surveillance of air operators FRMS if applicable.
- Improper approvals can generate a USOAP findings, that will be shared with all other member States and depending on the severity of the finding may result in a Significant Safety Concern
