Dear Mr. Benjamin,

I have the honour to refer to your letter AN 12/44.6-11/1 of 21 January 2011.

With reference to ICAO Assembly resolution A37-10 on Proficiency in the English language used for radiotelephony communications, please be informed that Republic of Lithuania is fully compliant with the ICAO regulations specifying the ICAO aviation language proficiency requirements for air traffic controllers and flight crew members.

All air traffic controllers and flight crew members who are required to use the radio telephone aboard an aircraft in accordance with para 1.2.9 of Annex 1 to Convention hold licences issued by Civil Aviation Administration of Lithuania with endorsement at least Level 4 of English language proficiency.
