I have the pleasure to respond to your letter AN 12/44.6-07/68 dated October 26, 2007 and the attached Resolution A36-11 "Proficiency in the English language used for radiotelephony".

In this opportunity, I would like to inform you that all pilots involved in international operations in which the English language is required, will comply as minimum with Operational Level 4 by 5 March 2008, in accordance with the ICAO rating scale established in Annex 1.

For this reason, I am submitting **Attachment A** with this letter containing the details of our focal point and the national regulatory framework for the implementation of language proficiency requirements.
