Current Assistance Programs Under the Aviation Security Mechanism

- Responding to States Needs and Requests Upon Requests through the Plan of Action
- Technical Assistance through the Technical Program. (Technical Assistance)

New Program Coordinated Assistance

Objectives:

Program is an enhanced approach to:

- Help ICAO States remedy aviation security deficiencies discovered in the ICAO Universal Aviation Security Program (USAP)

Coordinated Assistance Cont.

- Assist states to address new and emerging challenges in aviation security.
- Assist deal in addressing unexpected and sudden developments in aviation security due to attacks and imminent threats.

Coordinated Assistance Cont

- Help and guide states to develop sustainable aviation security infrastructure and avoid current incremental approaches.

Coordinated Assistance Cont.

- Avoid Redundancy and duplicity in providing technical assistance on unilateral and bilateral levels.
